Tuesday June 1, 2010, Cairo / Sakkara and Giza pyramids

After breakfast at our hotel, we board our luxury motor coach to begin a magical day visiting Sakkara pyramid, **Sphinx** with its unsolved mysteries, and walk among the **Pyramids** and stand at the base of one of the wonders of the world. Thursday June 3, 2010, Khan El-Khalili / Nile cruise 1

After breakfast, start our full day in Cairo visiting **Khan El-Khalili**, one of the earliest and greatest markets in the Middle East, built in the 14th century AD and containing many stores that exhibit wonderful collections of jewellery, wooden products engraved with mother-of-pearl, perfumes and many more exciting souvenirs. You can bring your custom orders to them, or buy some of the lovely treasures right off the rack. In the afternoon, we'll be transferred to Cairo airport for the departure to Aswan. Upon arrival, we'll transfer to 5 star cruise.

Dinner and overnight.

Friday June 4, 2010, Aswan / Nile cruise 2

We'll take a tour in the nice city of **Aswan** and we'll visit the **High Dam**, the **Unfinished Obelisk**, the **Philae Temple**, felucca ride to the **Nubian Village**, and the **Elephantine Island**.

Saturday June 5, 2010, Aswan / Nile cruise 3

For those who are participating in the optional tour to **Abu-Simbel** will leave at 4:00 AM and come back to Aswan at 12:30 PM. Sail to **Kom-Ombo**, visit the temple of **Kom-Ombo**, and sail to **Edfu**.

Monday June 7, 2010 / Day tour in the west bank of Luxor

Cross to the west bank of the Nile where you visit the Temples and Necropolises built to commemorate the Dead.

Valley of the Kings, **King Tutankamon**, **Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (Deir El Bahari)**, and the **Gigantic Colossi of Memnon (Remains of Amunhotep III Temple)**. Check-in to your 5*hotel in **Luxor** (**Steigenberger Nile Palace hotel** or similar 5* hotels.)

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Tuesday June 8, 2010 / East bank of Luxor & Sharm el Sheikh 01

Enjoy an open buffet breakfast and check out your hotel.

With your personal ENGLISH or FRENCH Speaking guide, enjoy an excursion To **Luxor Temple** to see its courtyard & the granite statues of **Ramses II**. Proceed to **Karnak** which is a

series of temples built in different ages. Starting by the avenue of **Ram-Headed Sphinxes**, visit the **Unfinished Pylon**, the **Hypostyle Hall** with its 134 gigantic columns, temple of **Amun** adorned with Lotus & Papyrus Designs. Transfer to Luxor Airport to fly to **Sharm el Sheikh**.
